Team Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Crew lists must have a min. 16, max. 26 including sweep and drummer</li> <li>Mixed teams must have min. 8 female paddlers</li> <li>Women teams must be 100% women stem-stern</li> <li>BCS teams must be 100% BCS stem-stern</li> <li>All teams <b>must</b> an allocated L2+ sweep</li> <li>Team members (paddler, drummer or sweep) can only be on ONE standard crew list.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Crew lists must have a min. 8, max. 14 including sweep and drummer</li> <li>Open crews may have any composition</li> <li>Mixed crews must have a min. 4 female paddlers</li> <li>Women crews must be 100% women stem-stern</li> <li>BCS crews must be 100% BCS stem-stern</li> <li>All teams <b>must</b> have an allocated L2+ sweep</li> <li>- Crew members may be double rostered outside their grade as long as it does not interfere with races. Races and boats will not be held to wait for unavailable crew members.</li> </ul>
